

Dr Andrew J Souter: Brief CV

He currently works as a Consultant in Anaesthesia and Pain Medicine at the Royal United Hospital Bath NHS Trust, a post he has held for more than 20 years. He spends approximately 60 per cent of his time in the pain clinic. He undertook postgraduate training in anaesthesia in the Oxford Radcliffe Hospitals. He received specialist training in pain management at the Regional Pain Relief Unit in Oxford and spent 15 months in the University of Texas, Southwestern Medical Centre where he received the Diploma of Fellowship in Pain Management. He received the Fellowship of the Faculty of Pain Medicine in 2008. He has published papers and book chapters in the fields of neuropathic and back pain. He has edited and published a book "Back Pain" OUP 2012 ISBN 978-0-19-960977-2. He undertook a course in medico-legal report writing in 2005. He completed the Cardiff University Bond Solon Expert Witness Certificate in 2016 and writes approximately 20 chronic pain related medico-legal reports per year generally at the instruction of the claimant or as a single joint expert, occasionally for the defendant.
